

Bungee jumping is an adventurous sport. People jump from higher ground such as a bridge with an elastic rope tied to their ankles to stop them from hitting the ground. The rope is special. When people jump, they wear safety equipment like helmets and a special jacket.

It started as the coming-of-age ceremony in a small village on South Pentecost Island in Vanuatu. In this ceremony the young men jumped from the top of a 30 meter- high tree to demonstrate their courage as an adult. And from then it started to become an extreme sport. People took part in this sport and it was named bungee jumping.

Modern bungee jumping began when four British men jumped off the Golden Gate Bridge in San Francisco. In 1987, A.J. Hackett became world famous when he jumped from the Eiffel Tower in Paris. Later he set up the Kawarau Bridge in New Zealand, with a height of 47 meters, as a commercial bungee jumping area. People could pay money for the fun of jumping. The idea quickly spread around the world.

Bungee jumping has several dangers. The rope has to be the right size for your weight, or it may break. The safety jacket has to fit properly or the force of the drop could cause a person's bones to break. The rope has to be the right length or a person could hit the ground before being stopped by the rope. Safety is very important.
